



RED WINES

Cabernet Sauvignon

Silver Palm, North Coast, CA - \$35

Lavish black currant, dried cherry, sage, peppercorn and wood smoke aromas with chocolate, espresso and creamy vanilla.

Earthquake, Lodi, CA - \$40

Over the top and shattering to the veins with juicy plum, spicy clove and full bodied.

**Francis Ford Coppola Directors Cut,
Alexander Valley, CA - \$40**

Aromas of cola, cherry and eucalyptus before revealing dark, rich berries, cassis and black cherries.

Beringer Third Century, North Coast - \$35

Flavors of cola, ripe black cherry and a hint of tobacco. Full of spice and black fruit.

Merlot

Blackstone Sonoma Reserve, CA - \$32

Fresh raspberry, black currant, clove and vanilla with a hint of earthiness.

Oberon, Napa Valley, CA - \$35

Ripe fruit with blueberries and chocolate.

Calvaresi, Bernville, PA - \$25

Black cherry and plum fruit in the nose and taste. Toasty finish with full and soft tannins.

Tin Roof, North Coast, CA - \$24

Ripe, luscious black cherry and plum fruit aromas and flavors with hints of tobacco, herbal spice and chocolate.

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Red Zinfandel

Windmill Old Vine, Lodi, CA - \$35

Aromas of blackberries, bing cherries and vanilla with hints of dark chocolate.

Valley of the Moon, Glen Ellen, CA - \$35

An excellent example of red Zin from Sonoma, California. Medium bodied with great fruit.

Cline Ancient Vine, Sonoma, CA - \$38

These grapes are from 80-100 year old vines and burst with flavors of dark berries, coffee and chocolate.

Cline, Sonoma, CA - \$25

A very nice Sonoma red Zin with subtle tannins and fruit flavors of black cherry and raspberry and a vanilla finish.

Pinot Noir

Beringer Third Century, Central Coast, CA - \$35

Bright fruit flavors of cherry and cranberry, hints of white pepper that carries way to an elegant finish.

Chateau St. Jean, Sonoma, CA - \$37

Aromas of cherry and plum as well as hints of cedar and leather. Palate offers jammy fruit flavors and fine tannins.

Kenwood, Sonoma, CA - \$32

Intense aromas of raspberries and dried cherries followed by subtle aromas of spice and vanilla; rich, full-bodied texture with a smooth, long finish.

Steele, Carneros, CA - \$36

Strawberry and cherry preserves on the nose and on the palate along with hints of oak, vanilla and cassis.

Greg Norman, Sonoma, CA - \$36

Fruit forward flavors of ripe cherry and strawberry are delivered with a smooth mouth feel and lingering silky tannins.

Merry Edwards, Sonoma Coast, CA - \$62

95 points Wine Spectator

Its bright aroma effuses floral accents of violets laced with blueberries, black raspberries and a hint of exotic brown spice.

Steele, Carneros, CA - \$36

Strawberry and cherry preserves on the nose and on the palate along with hints of oak, vanilla and cassis.

Other Interesting Reds

Windmill Old Vine, Lodi, CA - \$35

Aromas of blackberries, Bing cherries and vanilla with hints of dark chocolate.

Barossa Valley Shiraz, Australia - \$30

This Shiraz exhibits cherries, dark berry fruit and spice with subtle oak nuances.

Storm Hock Pinotage, South Africa - \$25

Bright, vibrant aromas, velvety texture and ripe jammy fruit flavors.

Laposta Malbec, Argentina - \$35

Deep red color with tannins and a great plum flavor.

Petite Petite, Lodi, CA - \$38

Full of blueberry, plum, violet and bold tannins. Blend of Petite Sirah and Petite Verdot.

Windmill Petite, Lodi, CA - \$28

Ripe blackberry and brown sugar flavors. Finishing smooth with a touch of oak and spice.

Owners Recommendation

Earthquake Petite Sirah, Lodi, CA - \$40

Upfront blueberry syrup, black cherry and coffee bean with a finish of cedar and vanilla flavors.
